Directions to Victor's Residenz-Hotel

Victor's Residenz-Hotel Berlin is situated in a quiet but central location, adjacent to the boroughs of Berlin Mitte, Prenzlauer Berg, and Friedrichshain. Volkspark Friedrichshain can be accessed just across the street from the hotel. The closest bus stop (#200) is literally on Victor's doorstep, and the closest tram stop (#M 4) can be found 250 metres down the street. At tenminute intervals you can catch a ride to the fair grounds, go on a sightseeing tour, or jump right into the city's nightlife. Alexanderplatz can be reached in just a few minutes on foot.

From Tegel Airport:

You can catch the ExpressBus TXL and get off at the *Alexanderplatz* stop. Switch to the #200 bus going in the direction of *Michelangelostraße*, and get off at the *Am Friedrichshain* stop, or reach the hotel on foot (15 minutes walk).

From Bahnhof Zoo via Potsdamer Platz and Alexanderplatz:

Take the #200 bus going in the direction of *Michel-angelostraße*, and get off at the *Am Friedrichshain* stop or reach the hotel on foot (15 minutes walk).

From Berlin/Ostbahnhof Station, Berlin/Central Station – Lehrter Bahnhof:

Take the #142 bus and get off at the *Am Friedrichshain* stop.
