Description: Professional internships, for academic credit in the Liberal Arts, available in a discipline appropriate to students' abilities, major area of studies and relative ability in English and/or German. Students complete an internship conducted full time, lasting four weeks at the end of the semester. All internships follow guidelines for all academic internships taken through Nazareth College, at home or abroad. By the time of the internship all students will (and should) have at least a basic working knowledge of German. Students with less knowledge of the language will be placed in environments where good English language skills (communicating and writing) are required. Good computer skills are a definite advantage. Students with proficiency in the German language have a broader range of options. Suitable academic preparation is required in some cases.

Internship areas may include:

- business
- government
- political and cultural foundations and NGOs
- museums
- theatres
- education
- international organizations; etc.

All students must present an up-to-date résumé and at least two photographs. Internship sites are assigned in consultation with the student and advisement from the student's home campus.

Internships are unpaid.

The internship can be substituted with an independent research project with a special mentor or with an additional language course.
